Rodeo Arena setup for the 4-H livestock sale. Canvas should be here to setup the tent and then Todd and crew can get into setup the sale ring, holding pens and alleyways. JH Adventure Rentals is bringing the chairs and we can gather up the small bleachers from around Mateosky. Matt, we need to get the parking cash boxes out by 10:45AM. The beer garden opens at 4:00PM so we need to get that ready and delivered about 3:45PM. Buyer's Reception starts at 4:00PM. WY Cowboy Hall of Fame goes on at 4:40/4:45PM and the sale starts at 5:00PM. Elks are really happy with the Square terminal. After-Party at the Big Top Tent from 8:30-11:30PM.
